I am deeply grateful for the many ways you have surrounded me with care. Your prayers, kind messages, and the gifts of flowers, soups, and fresh bread have been a true blessing. Each gesture has been a reminder that I am held in a community of love.

It has also been heartening to hear that you are enjoying the ministry of those who have been leading worship in my absence. I give thanks for their presence among you, and for the continued life and spirit of the congregation. And like many of you, I am grateful for the long-awaited arrival of spring—a visible sign of new life stirring all around us.

In many ways, this season of Easter mirrors what I am experiencing personally: a turning toward hope, a sense of newness, and the gradual but real movement beyond what has been difficult.
